Participation Conditions and Requirements

1. The exhibition is open to the participation of all national and international artists and academics.
2. Participation is free of charge.
3. The subject/theme is free.
4. Participants may apply with a maximum of 1 (one) work.
5. A digital e-catalog (PDF) will be published on the website within one month following the exhibition.

6. Work images must be of suitable quality for online display, in **JPEG format, and at 300 dpi resolution(high resolution)**.
7. The exhibition is open to all disciplines of visual arts such as painting, sculpture, photography, ceramics, printmaking, graphic design, digital art, installation and mixed media.
8. The subject line of the email must be written as "**8 March Exhibition Submission - Name Surname**". The email body must include the image of the work, the **Artist's Name-Surname, Work Details (Title, Technique, Dimensions, Year)**.
9. The Exhibition Participation Form must be saved with the artist's **(Name_Surname)**. The required information on the form must be filled out, **signed**, and included as an email attachment.

10. The exhibition is non-juried; all submissions meeting the technical requirements will be accepted.
11. Participants are deemed to have given permission for their work to be published for non-commercial purposes on official websites, social media, e-catalogs, posters, etc.
12. Applications must be submitted via the specified email address; incomplete or incorrect applications will not be included in the exhibition.
13. Works containing racism, discrimination, violence, nudity, hate speech, or elements contrary to general moral codes will be excluded from the scope of the exhibition. (The Exhibition Organizing Committee reserves the right to exclude works that do not meet display standards in terms of artistic competence, originality, and plastic language).
